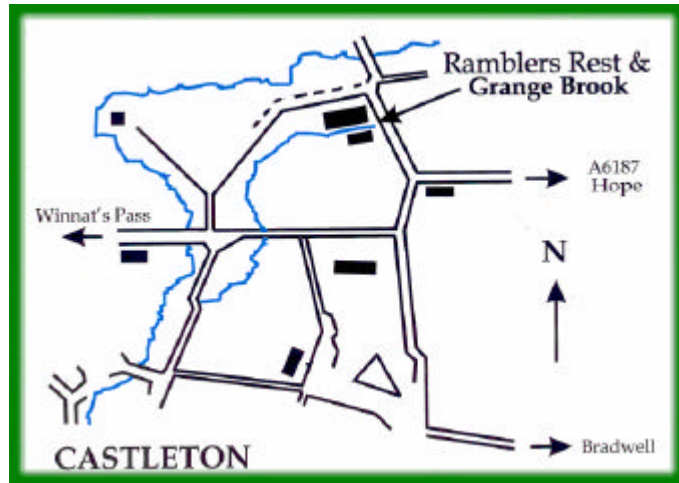

Built in the 17th Century, The Rambler's Rest is situated in the heart of Castleton, in the beautiful Peak District National Park. It is in easy reach of: Derwent Dams; Chatsworth, Haddon Hall, Eyam, Bakewell, Buxton and Sheffield.

Accommodation:

There are three en-suite rooms offering facilities for disabled guests.

- One ground floor bedroom is accessible, accessed via a wide accessible door from the road. There is one step down from the entrance to the bedroom, but a portable ramp is provided.
- En suite bathroom - traditional bathroom (bath and toilet), a handrail is not provided.
- On request, breakfast can be served in the bedroom.
- There are also two ground floor bedrooms offered en-suite, these are accessed via two steep steps leading into the reception area, no portable ramp is provided.
- The wet room is on the same floor as the bedrooms.
- The Breakfast room is on level access.
- All bedrooms have colour TV and tea making facilities.
- Children and well-behaved pets are welcome.
